

Emig's Launch Rules

1. Flying this site alone is discouraged.
2. P2 pilots must be accompanied by a minimum P3 certified pilot.
3. Only current Bozeman Alpine Paragliding Club (BAPC) members may use Daniel Emig's private property access. However, non-flying guests may accompany members.
4. No dogs are allowed on any part of the premises, which includes leaving dogs in parked cars.
5. All pilots must sign this agreement to abide by these rules and receive a site orientation by a current BAPC member prior to flying the site.
6. Pilots agree not to launch or land on Emig's property or anywhere within the subdivision.
7. All pilots must use the corridor of access, as approved by Daniel Emig, and no other part of the property. Parking will be designated by Daniel Emig.
8. BAPC has purchased and maintains a \$1,000,000 comprehensive general liability insurance policy which names landowner Daniel Emig as insured.
9. Pilots should be on property only during legally flyable hours (30 minutes before sunrise through 30 minutes after sunset).
10. Access will be used for paragliding activities only and not for other purposes such as hunting, camping, hiking, skiing, or mountain biking.
11. All pilots and their guests agree to an assumption of risk to person or property in signing this agreement and using the access corridor. Mr. and Mrs. Emig are not responsible for you in any way.
12. Daniel Emig agrees to allow private property access for BAPC members; however, he may terminate this agreement if the Club violates any of the above provisions, but only after a written warning to the BAPC.
13. If Daniel Emig sells or transfers the property, this agreement is still valid until expiration of the insurance policy on March 1, 2011.
